

AŽ009/2026 Call for Quotations Provision of Telephony, Internet and Related Communication Services by Aġenzija Żgħażaġh

Aġenzija Żgħażaġh invites quotations from suitably licensed service providers for the provision, migration, support, and maintenance of its existing telephony, internet, and related communication services under a single consolidated service arrangement.

1. Scope of the Call

1.1 The selected provider shall supply all services currently required by the Agency, including any necessary migration, installation, porting, configuration, testing, activation and ongoing support, with minimal disruption to operations.

2. Required Services

3. General Requirements

3.1 The quotation shall cover one consolidated service arrangement under a single provider.

3.2 The provider shall retain and port all existing numbers and services as required by the Agency.

3.3 The provider shall ensure continuity of service during migration and changeover.

3.4 All necessary equipment, configuration, activation and support required for the above services shall be included.

3.5 The provider shall indicate response times for faults and the support channels available to the Agency.

3.6 Quotations shall clearly state all recurring charges, one-time charges and any optional charges.

3.7 The Agency reserves the right to increase, decrease or reassign services according to operational needs during the contract period.

4. Duration

4.1 The contract shall be for a period of two (2) years from the date of award, unless otherwise stated in the call documents.

5. Submission of Quotations

5.1 Interested bidders shall submit a financial quotation together with a brief technical offer confirming compliance with the required services, service levels, migration approach and support arrangements. Submissions are to be received by post to Aġenzija Żgħażaġħ, St. Joseph High Road, Santa Venera SVR1013 by no later than Monday, 30th March 2026 at noon CET.

5.2 Applications sent by registered mail must allow sufficient time to ensure delivery by the specified deadline. Aġenzija Żgħażaġħ will acknowledge receipt in writing within one working day.

6. Award Criterion

6.1 The contract shall be awarded to the cheapest technically compliant offer.

7.1 Aġenzija Żgħażaġħ reserves the right to reject any or all submissions and to award this quotation partially or in whole.

7.2 Late applications will not be considered.
