

Expression of Interest for Media Literacy Expert Practitioners with Aġenzija Żgħażaġħ

- 1.0 Aġenzija Żgħażaġħ is collaborating with the Directorate for STEM and VET Programmes in the Ministry for Education, Sport, Youth, Research and Innovation to launch the fourth edition of the Jumpstart Summer Bootcamp, an educational programme in film-making for young people between 13 and 16 years.
- 2.0 Jumpstart aims to encourage young filmmakers to develop their creative and technical skills in film-making. It seeks to motivate young people in secondary schools to produce their films while providing them with opportunities to receive mentoring and guidance from established filmmakers. Young people who participate in the Summer Bootcamp have the platform to showcase their work with other young people from different schools during the Jumpstart Film Festival which will be held in April 2026. - 3.0 The programme will be held over ten (10) sessions from the 6th July 2026 until the 17th July 2026. The sessions will be held between 08.30 and 13:00 hours. Sessions will introduce young people to the fundamental elements of :
 - 3.1 Story development- developing a story of a short film script
 - 3.2 Pre-production – Screenwriting, finding your team and use of equipment
 - 3.3 Production – Film shooting
 - 3.4 Post-production – Editing visuals and audio
- 4.0 The proposed sessions should cover issues related to creative, technical, interpersonal, analytical and problem-solving skills.
- 5.0 The chosen expert/s will collaborate with the youth workers at Aġenzija Żgħażaġħ and the Media Literacy Educational Officer to prepare for the sessions.
- 6.0 An expression of interest should be submitted to Aġenzija Żgħażaġħ, and must include the following:
 - 6.1 A description of the practitioner's expertise and an outline of the sessions' content and their area of expertise.
 - 6.2 The cost per hour is Euro 21.50 including VAT, preparation delivery and evaluation inclusive, but excludes the resources which will be provided by Aġenzija Żgħażaġħ and the Directorate for STEM and VET Programmes in the Ministry for Education.
 - 6.3 A Europass CV.
 - 6.4 A Police Conduct (to be presented for verification only during the interview).
- 7.0 Eligible practitioners that include but are not limited to
 - 7.1 Teaching experience in Media Literacy Education or filmmaking.
 - 7.2 A degree at MQF Level 6 in a subject related to Media or filmmaking.
